

Flower Fairy Hats for Innocent smoothies bigknit

Level and explanation:
Stiches used are: Chain Stitch (CH)
Slip stitch (SS)
Double Treble (DTR)
Double Treble Cluster (DTR CL) - see images in Visual AID
Materials:
Hook Size:
Direction \& Style:
Double knit yarn of various colours 2.5-3.00 mm - to keep hat snuggly Both the hat and the flowers are worked in a circle, each row is finished off with a slip stitch.

## THE HAT

ROW 1: work 2 chains, then work 6 double crochet stitches into the second chain from hook, slip stitch into the $1^{\text {st }}$ double crochet. (6 stitches)
ROW 2: 1 chain, 2 double crochet in each of the double crochet, slip stitch into $1^{\text {st }} \mathrm{DC}$ (12 stitches).
ROW 3: 1 chain, *2 double crochet in the first DC, 1 double crochet in the following DC*, repeat * * five more times, slip stitch into $1^{\text {st }}$ DC (in effect you are increasing only in every other stitch, as opposed to every stitch in row 2); (18 stitches).
ROW 4: 1 chain, ${ }^{2}$ 2 double crochet in the first DC, 1 double crochet in the following 2 DC *, repeat * * five more times, slip stitch into $1^{\text {st }}$ DC (in effect you are increasing only in every third stitch in this row); (24 stitches).
ROW 5: 1 chain, *2 double crochet in the first DC, 1 double crochet in the following $3 D C^{*}$, repeat *

* five more times, slip stitch into $1^{\text {st }}$ DC (in effect you are increasing in every $4^{\text {th }}$ stitch in this row); (30 stitches).
ROW 6-15: 1 chain, 1 double crochet in each double crochet, slip stitch into the $1^{\text {st }}$ DC. ( 30 Stitches).
ROW 16: change colour, 3 Chains, 1 Double Treble in each of the Double crochet, Slip stitch to the top of the $1^{\text {st }}$ Double treble, finish off and weave in ends.


## The FLOWER with 5 petals

Begin with $5 \mathrm{CH}, 1 \mathrm{SS}$ in the first chain made - to close the chain circle
ROW 1: * $5 \mathrm{CH}, 4$ DTR cluster, $5 \mathrm{CH}, 1 \mathrm{DC}$ * into the circle, repeat * * four times, then $5 \mathrm{CH}, 4 \mathrm{DTR} \mathrm{CL}$, $5 \mathrm{CH}, \mathrm{SS}$ into the circle, finish and weave in ends.

VISUAL AID - DTR CL:


1. 5 CH and yarn over twice for the first TR
2. 2. 4 DTR CL ready to be finished

1. Closure of the Cluster
2. $5 \mathrm{CH}, 1$ DC back into the circle
