



Granny Square – easy – teaches you how to make a classic square



Linear Crochet – easy – teaches you how to create squares and rectangles using Double Crochet and chain stitch. We will create a small dish cloth to practice the technique...



Circle and Spiral – easy – basic building of a circle and a spiral using Double Crochet stitch



Bavarian Flowers – easy – medium difficulty – we touch on reading a pattern, show you how to create flowers using a few different stitches



Bavarian Square aka wool Eater – medium – you will learn the basics of a Bavarian crochet technique and how to make squares from it – you can easily use these as coasters... ☺ Another skill included in this lesson is changing of colour in Bavarian crochet specifically...



Bavarian Bunting – medium – at the end of this course you will be able to make as many triangles for your bunting as you need. And we will also teach you how to put them together!!!!



Victorian Style Flower in a square – easy to medium – you will be able to crochet a beautiful 3D effect flower and then continue on to be able to create a square around it for ease of connecting them to a finished blanket/cushion cover.



Popcorn stitch flower square – medium – illustrates how to make a lovely textured square using popcorn stitch.



Popcorn stitch dish cloth – medium – cotton dishcloths are great and why not make them a little more interesting than just flat? This popcorn stitch one will both clean your dishes and please your eye...



Shapes and Creatures – easy – illustrates how to increase and decrease and how to create oval/round 3D objects – basic skill building for making toys...



Crochet Coasters – easy – this technique teaches you how to create a set of coasters in an attractive lacy flower pattern.



Freeform Crochet – basic skills required – this lesson teaches you more about freeform crochet and how it can develop – depending on your previous experience, new stitches are introduced and demonstrated.

Own theme – student directed – if you are an experienced crocheter you may benefit from some time to develop your ideas, reading a particularly tricky pattern or help with whatever you are stuck on...
